Science teachers are invited to be part of an exciting new program, Be E³ Smart. Facilitated by the Ohio Energy Project, participating teachers in grades 5-12 will:

- Attend a professional development.
- Receive a kit of equipment to teach the science of energy and efficiency through classroom labs.
- Receive student energy kits. Students will be empowered as the “energy leaders” of their families by installing energy efficient measures at home.

Each student kit contains:

- Two 23 watt Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs
- Two 13 watt Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs
- Energy Use Gauge Thermometer
- LED Night Light
- Refrigerator Thermometer
- Hot Water Temperature Card
- Energy Conservation Wheel



Students conduct classroom labs to investigate energy efficiency, then take home a kit of materials to make their homes more efficient.

Q: *When will I be notified if I am selected as a participant?*

A: Registration will be open until October 7, 2009. You will be notified by October 9, 2009 if you are selected. Applications will continue to be received as spots remain available. All confirmations will be done via your school email address.

Q: *Will I receive my deposit back?*

A: Yes. Your \$50 deposit reserves your spot at the professional development. Your check will not be cashed and you will receive it at the completion of the workshop. Your deposit is only forfeited if you do not attend the professional development.

Q: *How do you select participants?*

A: Priority will be given to the following teachers:

- Only participants teaching in schools served by DP&L will be selected.
- 5th-12th grade science teachers.
