



# Frequently Asked Questions

## 2012 Southwest Ohio Energy Sources Blitz

**Q: When will I be notified if I am selected as a participant?**

**A:** Registration will be open until March 23<sup>rd</sup>. You will be notified by March 28<sup>th</sup> if you were selected or placed on the wait list. Applications will continue to be received as spots remain available after March 23<sup>rd</sup>.

**Q: How do you select participants?**

**A:** The Blitz is open to 5<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade Ohio science teachers. Priority will be given to teachers in the electric service territory of our sponsors. Past Energy Sources Tour participants are eligible to apply.

**Q: What is the cost for the Energy Sources Blitz?**

**A:** Transportation, meals and lodging (double occupancy) are FREE! If selected, you will be asked for a \$50 deposit to hold your spot, but it will be returned at the end of the Blitz. Your deposit is only forfeited if you cancel 30 days or less prior to the trip departure date.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The deposit is not due until you are accepted. Please **DO NOT** send it with your application.

**Q: Is graduate credit available?**

**A:** No, graduate credit is not available for the Energy Sources Blitz. You will receive documentation for ten professional development contact hours.

**Q: What time is the Blitz?**

**A:** The first day of the Blitz we will meet at a hotel in the departure city from 7:00p-9:00p for a session of hands on energy explorations and classroom activities. The second day of the Blitz will be from approximately 8:00a-5:30p for touring energy sites in the area.

**Q: I live near the departure city. Do I have to stay at the hotel?**

**A:** No. If you would prefer to stay at home that is fine. However, you must attend the evening session at the hotel in order to participate in the bus tour of energy sites.

**Q: I would prefer not to ride the bus. Can I drive myself?**

**A:** Due to security requirements and parking limitations at the sites, all participants will need to ride the bus.
