Frequently Asked Questions

2016 Central Ohio Tour & Eastern Ohio Blitz

Q: When will I be notified if I am selected as a participant?

A: Open registration will occur until March 18th. You will be notified by March 24th if you have been selected to participate. Applications will continue to be received as spots remain available after March 24th.

Q: How do you select participants?

A: Priority will be given to the following teachers:

- 1st time participants (2nd time participants will NOT be accepted for the tour, educators may participate in the Blitz multiple times)
- 3rd-12th grade Ohio science teachers with a 2016-17 classroom assignment
- Teachers in the electric service territory of our sponsors
- One teacher per school (multiple teachers may apply and will be accepted as space allows)

Q: What is the cost for the Energy Sources Tour & Blitz?

A: Transportation, meals and lodging (double occupancy) are FREE! If selected, you will be asked for a deposit to hold your spot, but it will be returned at the end of the Tour/Blitz. Your deposit is only forfeited if you cancel 30 days or less prior to the trip departure date.

Tour: \$100 refundable deposit

Blitz: \$50 refundable deposit

Q: How much graduate credit is available and how much does it cost?

A: *Tour:* One semester hour (\$175) or two semester hours (\$350) from Ashland University.

Blitz: One semester hour (\$175) from Ashland University.

A course syllabus will be posted online March 1st. Contact hours will be awarded for both workshops.
